

Pink Tea (Kuhano vino)



The recipe for Pink Tea (Kuhano vino) is from Marie Prisland. Kuhano Vino (cooked wine) as it is called in Slovenia, was renamed 'Pink Tea' at a party 90 years ago by the members of Branch 1, Sheboygan. It is served with cookies or potica. This traditional drink continues to be popular among the Slovenians in Sheboygan and is in demand for many ethnic social functions in the community. Printed in Zarja, November/December 1976.

1 pint red wine
1 pint of water
1 cinnamon stick
1 clove
1 slice lemon (cut crosswise)
1 slice orange (cut crosswise)
Sugar to taste (about 1/3 to 1/2 cup)

Bring above to boil, remove cinnamon, clove and fruit slices. Serve hot with cookies or potica.
